### **6:30 to 7:15 Steering Committee**

*Topic:*

- Sub-Committee Briefings. Working off the topic worksheets sub committees will be reporting back to the Steering Committee on those issues and priorities that are of greatest and most obvious importance. These priorities will provide constant reminders to the Steering Committee during their code development suggestions. Sub committees will provide this report in response to the questions and assignments spelled out in the topic worksheets. Some responses will be based on a review of the collection of existing information while others will be based on sub-committee discussions and consensus.

*Goal:*

- Sub Committees will be able to provide a list of their top priorities to the Steering Committee so that they are able to contemplate those priorities during their code development discussions. This is only a preliminary list of the most important matters.

### **7:15 to 7:30 Steering Committee**

*Topic:*

- Introduction of Draft Business Village Standards
- Introduction of Draft Business General Standards

*Goal:*

- This will be the initial staff draft of the regulations for both zoning designations. At the close of this meeting, the Steering Committee will have a list of the sub committees top priorities and a first draft of development regulations. Additional (and more refined) input from the sub committees will continue to be provided to the Steering Committee as it moves through its discussions.

### **7:30 to 8:30 Sub Committees**

*Topic:*

- Strategies for Implementing Ideas. Now that sub-committees have had a few weeks to think about different concepts and priorities that they would like to bring to Freeland it is time to talk about the different methods of making these ideas become reality. Development regulations can only do so much. Other strategies are needed to carry out some of the goals. Those strategies may include public financing, public works, creating incentives, etc. Staff will spend the first portion of this discussion talking about the differences.

*Goal:*

- To have sub committees attempt to categorize the different ideas into those that can be accomplished through law vs. other techniques.
