Rates

We accept CASH or CHECK only

First Can or Large Bag: \$11.00

Each additional Cans or Large Bag: \$ 3.50

Unsecured Load Fee: \$ 5.00

Rates are based upon a 32 gallon can or bag - about 40-50 pounds each. Loose loads will be interpreted to accommodate the "per can" fees. Rates include a base fee of \$7.24 per vehicle and 3.6% solid waste tax.

Construction – Demo– Metal –Yard Waste – Large Items

Limited quantities of construction, demo, metal, and yard waste are accepted at this site. We cannot accept items over 4 feet in length. Attendant will refer these types of loads to our Coupeville Transfer Station or suggest other disposal options.

Household Hazardous Waste

Household hazardous waste is accepted free of charge. Antifreeze, gasoline, oil-based paints, fertilizers, pesticides, acids, bases, fluorescent bulbs, lead, PBC ballasts, propane tanks, mercury devices, etc. Notify the site attendant if you have hazardous waste.

Latex/Acrylic Paint & Stain

Latex/acrylic paint is accepted as household garbage and must be thickened to a non-pourable consistency. Large quantities may be referred to our Coupeville Transfer Station. Notify the site attendant if you have any paint or stain.

Recycling

Aluminum Cans: Clean foil OK.

Batteries: Tape exposed terminals.

Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags: Flattened corrugated cardboard.
→NO plastic, Styrofoam, packing materials, milk cartons, dirty cardboard.

Cell Phones: Place in plastic bag and recycle with household batteries.

Clothing: Place in the blue Northwest Center container.

E-cycle: TV's, monitors, CPU's, laptops, tablets and eReaders.

Glass Bottles & Jars: Rinse & remove lids. Separate by color (blue goes in with the green).

→NO window glass, light bulbs, stemware, drinking glasses, dishes, windshields or mirrors.

Mixed Paper, Magazines & Catalogs: Flattened box board (i.e. cereal & soda boxes), junk mail, magazines, phone books, papers from the office or home, wrapping paper, glue bound paperback books, shredded paper (in bags to keep them contained). We suggest shredding credit card offers & personal information.

→NO corrugated boxes, brown bags, used paper plates, bodily fluid contamination, toilet or facial tissue, milk cartons, ribbon, Styrofoam or plastic.

Newspaper: Newspapers and the inserts that come with the paper, news print flyers and publications, news print packing paper.

Oil, Motor or Cooking: See attendant.

Plastic: Only Bottles, Jugs & Dairy Tubs. Plastic is not accepted according to the recycle number.

→NO caps or lids, crispy plastics like deli containers, Styrofoam, meat trays or grocery/trash bags.

Tin: Rinsed, remove label, remove tops and bottoms to flattened - unless molded.

For safety and to keep litter off the roadways, Island County requires that loads are secured to your vehicle. According to the Washington State Department of Transportation, road debris causes about 350 accidents every year on state highways. Even if you are going a short distance and not driving on a highway, you are still required by law to secure your load.
